**SUBJECT: Acceptance of \$23,600 Grant Award from the Trust for Public Land for the
Division for Parks and Recreation**

Request: Council authorization to accept grant funds of \$23,600 from Trust for Public Land: On Common Ground: Activating Community Connections through Parks Programs for the Division of Parks and Recreation. No matching funds required.

Purpose of Request: LFUCG Division of Parks and Recreation has been awarded \$23,600 from Trust for Public Land for On Common Ground: Activating Community Connections through Parks Program. It is intended to support programs that promote contact and engagement between people from different social groups. Funds in the amount of \$20,000 will be used to activate summer programming offered by three Park and Recreation Programs: Therapeutic Recreation, Partnerships, and Community Summer Teen Retreat. The remaining \$3,600 of funds will be used for flight and incidental travel expenses related to Parks and Recreation's mandatory participation in the Trust for Public Land's Welcoming Interactive Conference. Any remaining travel funds may be applied to the program activation project.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? \$23,600 has been awarded for Fiscal Year 2023. No matching funds are required. Funds for future budget years are dependent upon availability of grant funds.

Are the funds budgeted? Budget amendment is in process.
