SUBJECT: KYTC Agreement for Oxford Circle Sidewalks Project —Design Phase

Request: Council authorization to accept federal funds in the amount of \$20,000 for the design phase of Oxford Circle Sidewalks Project as funded under the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Office of Local Programs Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP).

Purpose of the Request: On September 15, 2016 (Resolution 571-2016), Council approved submission of an application to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet requesting federal funds to design the construction of approximately 410 feet of sidewalk along Oxford Circle to connect Cambridge Drive to Versailles Road, providing a pedestrian connection between Cardinal Valley and the Versailles Road commercial corridor and transit line.


The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has offered the LFUCG funds for design phase in the amount of \$20,000. Local match in the amount of \$5,000 is required for a total project cost of \$25,000.

The cost in this budget year and future budget years: Design Cost in FY 2017: \$25,000 (\$20,000 federal funds and \$5,000 local match).

Are the funds budgeted? Budget Amendment #8249 is in process.
