**COUNTY GOVERNMENT:** 

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County

Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a grant from the Just Fund

Education Project, Incorporated, which grant funds are in the amount of \$5,000.00, for the

purpose of milling and resurfacing the intersection of Limestone and Short Streets and

adding a rainbow design, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County

Government for the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is

hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County

Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account

appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget

previously established for this Grant.
