This memorandum is to notify the Urban County Council of Change Order No. 1 for the Town Branch Wet Weather Storage Facility Remedial Measure Project. Per CAO Policy No. 15R the Remedial Measures Program Manger is allowed to approve change orders of less than 5% of the cumulative contract award. The result of the attached Change Order No. 1 is to increase the original contract amount by \$289,309 or 1.5%, and an increase of contract time by 76 days.

This proposal also includes installing a temporary retaining wall near the diversion structure that is necessary due to schedule changes related to this work.
