SUBJECT: REQUEST COUNCIL AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE
PURCHASE OF SERVICE AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$150,260 WITH LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY
HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION

The proposed FY 2013 General Fund budget provides for \$150,260 to support the operating costs of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Human Rights Commission. The agency will continue to safeguard all individuals within Lexington-Fayette County from discrimination based on race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, disability, familial status and sexual orientation/gender identity in connection with housing, employment and public accommodations and to effect the provisions and purposes of the Kentucky Civil Rights Act (KRS Chapter 3444), Urban County Ordinance 199-94 and 201-99, provision 7.17 of the Lexington-Fayette Merger Charter of 1974, and any other laws enacted by the Lexington-Fayette Urban County relating to the Commission.

Council authorization to execute agreement is requested, subject to the availability of sufficient funds in FY 2013.
