SUBJECT: United States Tennis Association Grant Award

Request:

Council Authorization to accept an award of \$1,250 from the United States Tennis Association (USTA) for the Division of Parks and Recreation to operate the 2018 Summer Hispanic Tennis Clinic.

Why are you requesting?

The Division of Parks and Recreation submitted an application and has been offered grant funding from the United States Tennis Association (USTA) for the Lexington-Fayette County Parks and Recreation Summer Camp Program. As part of its summer programming, Lexington Parks & Recreation offers youth tennis clinics for participants 6-15 years old. Class sizes are limited and each clinic provides varying instruction as determined by the participants' ages and/or skill level.

The 2018 Summer Hispanic Tennis Clinic will engage participants from age six and up to encourage family participation. Following the lead of the USTA regarding the importance of engaging the local Hispanic community, this will be the first time Lexington Parks & Recreation will offer an expressly Hispanic Tennis Clinic option as part of its summer tennis programming.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? \$1,250 has been awarded for this budget year. No costs are anticipated in future budget years.

Are the funds budgeted? BA 9140 is in process.
