**SUBJECT:** Fire Training Incentive for Fiscal Year 2022

**Request:** Council authorization to accept award for Fire Training Incentive Grant in an amount up to \$3,333,170 for FY 2022 from the Commission on Fire Protection, Personnel, Standards, and Education for Training Incentives for Firefighters.

**Purpose of Request:** Fire Training Incentive funds are used to provide eligible firefighters with supplemental pay for participation in training programs. Supplemental pay in the amount of \$4,000 for each eligible firefighter (597 estimated sworn positions) is provided for a total of \$2,388,000. In addition, the program contributes up to 39.58% of that total towards the pension of participants, totaling \$945,170.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? Grant funds for Fiscal Year 2022 total \$3,333,170 with no local match required. Future years' funding is dependent upon availability of grant funding.

Are the funds budgeted? Budget amendment for Fiscal Year 2022 is in process.
