A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE KENTUCKY ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT CABINET, TO PROVIDE ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUESTED IN CONNECTION WITH THIS GRANT APPLICATION, AND TO ACCEPT THIS GRANT IF THE APPLICATION IS APPROVED, WHICH GRANT FUNDS ARE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$24,918.00 COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY FUNDS UNDER THE KENTUCKY RECYCLING GRANT PROGRAM, AND ARE FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWELVE DUMPSTERS TO BE PLACED AT SCHOOLS THAT PRODUCE LARGE QUANTITIES OF RECYCLABLE COMINGLED MATERIAL AND THREE ROLLOFF CONTAINERS TO BE PLACED IN PUBLIC AREAS THAT DO NOT HAVE RECYCLING SERVICES AVAILABLE, AND THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH OBLIGATES THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF \$7,587.00 AS A LOCAL MATCH AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED FUNDS WITHIN THE GRANT BUDGET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute and submit the Grant Application, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, to the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet and to provide any additional information requested in connection with this Grant Application, and to accept this Grant if the application is approved, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$24,918.00 Commonwealth of Kentucky funds under the Kentucky Recycling Grant Program, are for the purchase of twelve dumpsters to be placed at schools that produce large quantities of recyclable comingled material and three rolloff containers to be placed in public areas that do not have recycling services available, and the acceptance of which obligates the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of \$7,587.00 as a local match.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
