**SUBJECT:** MOU with University of Kentucky for Shared Mobility Program

**Request:** Council authorization to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the University of Kentucky for the terms and conditions of the scooter ride fee split and for the terms and conditions for the use of the shared mobility data management software from Populus.

**Purpose:** The Urban County Council established a fee structure for permits and use of shared mobility (dockless) vehicles that will be shared with the University of Kentucky through Ordinance 42-2019. This MOU states that the Government will share up to 50 percent of the amount of fees collected under Ordinance 42-2019. In addition, UK will use the mobility management software for its regulatory efforts on UK's campus.

**What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?** There is no cost to the Government. The fees that are collected for the shared mobility rides will be divided according to Ordinance 42-2019.

**Are the funds budgeted?** There is no budgetary impact.
