**SUBJECT:** Memorandum of Agreement for the Operations and Maintenance of Traffic Signals and Electrical Traffic Control Devices on the State Primary Road System


Through this Memorandum of Agreement the Lexington Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG), Division of Traffic Engineering, will assume certain specific obligations and responsibilities with regard to the operations and maintenance of traffic signals and electrical traffic control devices on the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KTC), Department of Highways, State Primary Road System in Fayette County.

The LFUCG is obligated to provide adequate staffing and services related to the safe and efficient operation of the computerized traffic signal control system and the timely and necessary maintenance of the Fayette County traffic signals and electrical control devices. In addition, the LFUCG will be responsible for all media and citizen inquiries and all public relations regarding the State Primary Route traffic signals.

This Agreement obligates the KTC to provide the LFUCG Division of Traffic Engineering funding not to exceed \$330,000 per state fiscal year for the purpose of operating and maintaining traffic signals and electrical traffic control devices.

The division requests approval of the MODIFICATION Agreement to change annual contract to \$330,000.00.
