Promulgation

The Lexington Fayette Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) dated January 2013 provides the framework in which responding departments and agencies, along with nongovernmental community partners, plan, coordinate, and perform their respective emergency functions during an emergency or disaster.

This plan supersedes all previous plans promulgated by Lexington Fayette and is officially adopted and approved by the Mayor and Urban County Council. This plan will be implemented whenever lifesaving and/or environmental or property protection services cannot by accomplished within the routine daily function of governmental departments or agencies within Lexington Fayette.

This plan is prepared in accordance with federal, state, and local statutes. It will be exercised, revised, and updated as required.

KRS 39B.030, Paragraph (3) states: "The executive order shall be filed with the office of the clerk for the local jurisdiction and a copy placed in the local emergency operations plan."

Signatories to the EOP:

The Lexington Fayette County Emergency Operations Plan and its supporting Emergency Support Functions dated March 21, 2013 is adopted as the official plan for providing emergency management services when lifesaving and property protection services cannot be accomplished as a normal daily function of county government departments and offices.
