i	<u>1032-17</u>	Authorization to execute Change Order No. 2 (Final) with Bluegrass Contracting Corporation for the Rogers Road Area Stormwater Improvements Project decreasing the contract price by the sum of \$36,163.73 - new contract total \$2,816,762.37 and extending the contract term by 244 calendar days from November 4, 2016 to July 6, 2017. k	<u>1039-17</u>	Authorization to enter into a License and Services Agreement with Tyler Technologies, Inc. This agreement provides maintenance and support services on an annual basis. The total one time cost is \$1,527,150 in initial year. There will be additional cost upon agreement renewal.
