**SUBJECT Request Council authorization to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 6 with the  
Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for continuation of design for Section II of the  
Todds/Liberty Road Improvement Project**

On February 25, 2004 (Ordinance 119-2008), Council approved acceptance of federal funds for Section II of the Todds Road and Liberty Road Improvement Project. This section begins at 0.2 miles south of Andover Forest/Forest Hill Drive to Interstate 75, a total distance of approximately 1.5 miles.

On May 10, 2012 (Resolution No. 216-2012), Council approved execution of Supplemental Agreement No. 3 providing LFUCG with additional design funds for the project.

On July 9, 2013 (Resolution No. 367-2013), Council approved Supplemental Agreement No. 4 providing LFUCG with \$1,000,000 for purchase of right of way.

On October 24, 2013 (Resolution No. 581-2013), Council approved Supplemental Agreement No. 5 providing LFUCG with \$1,954,000 for utility relocation.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has offered the LFUCG Supplemental Agreement No. 6 in the amount of \$438,000 for utility relocation. Funds are budgeted.
