Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a FY21 (Class B Infrastructure) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for Wesley United Methodist Church of Lexington, Kentucky, Inc., in the amount of \$24,000.00.

Purpose of Request

The purpose of this project is to conduct a feasibility study to explore the most suitable BMPs for use at 1825 Russell Cave Road, including but not limited to infiltration basins, forebays, rain gardens, vegetated swales, native plantings, bioretention, rainwater / runoff collection, and permeable pavement. The project also includes a study of the feasibility of stormwater educational components for the future.

Project Cost in FY21 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved for FY 2021 funding by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$24,000.00.
