**SUBJECT: Grant application for the Law Enforcement Service Fee Grant
Program—FY 2017**

Request:

Council authorization to submit application requesting funds in the amount of \$130,000 to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet under the Law Enforcement Service Fee Grant Program and accept award if offered for operation of a Traffic Alcohol for Fiscal Year 2017

Purpose of Request:

The Division of Police has prepared an application for submission to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet requesting funding in the amount of \$130,000 from the Law Enforcement Service Fee Program. If approved, these funds will be used to support costs of approximately 3,500 police officer overtime hours for a Traffic Alcohol Patrol. The source of funds is the Law Enforcement Service Fee Fund (derived from fees paid by offenders convicted of Driving Under the Influence).

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

If awarded, the cost in Fiscal Year 2017 will be \$130,000 for overtime expenses. No local match is required. Costs in future budget years are dependent upon availability of grant funds.

Are the funds budgeted?

Budget amendment is in process for Fiscal Year 2017.
