**SUBJECT: Amendment to Agreements with FoodChain**

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**Request:** Council authorization to execute amendment to agreement with FoodChain to move Community Development Block Grant program CARES Act funds to labor and fringe from supplies in the amount \$6,368.05.

**Purpose of Request:** On November 19, 2020 (Resolution 568-2020), Council authorized acceptance of federal Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) funds from U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) for response to COVID-19. FoodChain was awarded \$53,195 to provide food to eligible low to moderate income seniors impacted by the coronavirus in Lexington-Fayette County. FoodChain requests a grant adjustment to increase labor and salary and reduce supplies by \$6,368.05 for a total amount of \$53,195. This is due to need to cover staff working during the program.

**What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?** All funds were previously budgeted. Funds for future budget years are dependent upon availability of grant funds.

**Are the funds budgeted?** Grant funds are budgeted
