

SUBJECT: Request Approval of an Agreement with Steel Curtain Holdings, LLC to Lease Space to House Public Recycling and Waste Receptacles

Request: The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of an agreement with Steel Curtain Holdings, LLC to lease the space to house publically accessible comingled and paper recycling drop off receptacles.

Authorization to: Enter into an agreement with Steel Curtain Holdings, LLC to allow for placement of recycling dumpsters on Southland Drive to serve as a public drop off location for recyclables.

Why are you requesting? The Division of Waste Management provides public drop off receptacles for paper and comingled (mixed) recyclable materials in different areas of Lexington. This allows Lexington to offer convenient options so residents can drop off recyclables. The drop off location behind 439 – 455 Southland Drive has been one of the most highly utilized areas for the past few decades; due to spacing and safety variables, the dumpsters will be located on the area of land owned by Steel Curtain Holdings, LLC.
