Ë Investment Program Approve agreement with Tiffany and Company Jewelers, Inc. to participate in the Kentucky Business

up to 100% of its start-up and equipment costs through Kentucky corporate income tax credits and a wage assessment and local government enter into a 10-year agreement with the approved company under which the business can recover The Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority has given Tiffany and Company Jewelers, Inc. preliminary approval to participate in the Kentucky Business Investment (KBI) Program. The KBI Program requests that the state fee of up to 4%.

Company Jewelers plans to invest over \$2,000,000 in building improvements and new equipment for a 10-year period. plans to create 75 new jobs with an average wage of approximately \$40,000 per year plus benefits. wealth and provide additional job opportunities for the citizens of Lexington and the surrounding area. The company Tiffany and Company Jewelers' decision to expand their jewelry manufacturing operations in Lexington will create Tiffany and

the 10-year local 1% wage assessment through KBI. There is no budgetary impact on Lexington-Fayette Urban County It is recommended by the staff at Commerce Lexington for Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to approve Government.
