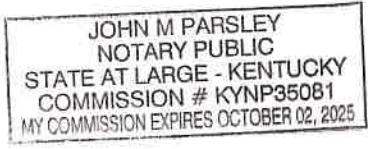

1.11 EQUAL OPPORTUNITY AGREEMENT

- (1) If any contractor is found by the department to have engaged in an unlawful practice under this chapter during the course of performing under a contract or subcontract covered under KRS 45.560 to 45.640, the department shall so certify to the contracting*

agency and such certification shall be binding upon the contracting agency unless it is reversed in the course of judicial review.

- (2) If the contractor is found to have committed an unlawful practice under KRS 45.560 to 45.640, the contracting agency may cancel or terminate the contract, conditioned upon a program for future compliance approved by the contracting agency and the department. The contracting agency may declare such a contractor ineligible to bid on further contracts with that agency until such time as the contractor complies in full with the requirements of KRS 45.560 to 45.640.*
- (3) The equal employment provisions of KRS 45.560 to 45.640 may be met in part by a contractor by subcontracting to a minority contractor or subcontractor. For the provisions of KRS 45.560 to 45.640, a minority contractor or subcontractor shall mean a business that is owned and controlled by one or more persons disadvantaged by racial or ethnic circumstances.*

KRS 45.630 Termination of existing employee not required, when

Any provision of KRS 45.560 to 45.640 notwithstanding, no contractor shall be required to terminate an existing employee upon proof that that employee was employed prior to the date of the contract.

KRS 45.640 Minimum skills

Nothing in KRS 45.560 to 45.640 shall require a contractor to hire anyone who fails to demonstrate the minimum skills required to perform a particular job.

In the case of an Agreement exceeding \$250,000, the Contractor will be required within seven (7) days following the Bid Opening to furnish evidence that its work-force in Kentucky is representative of the available work-force in the area from which it draws employees, or to supply an Affirmative Action plan which will achieve such representation during the life of the Contract.







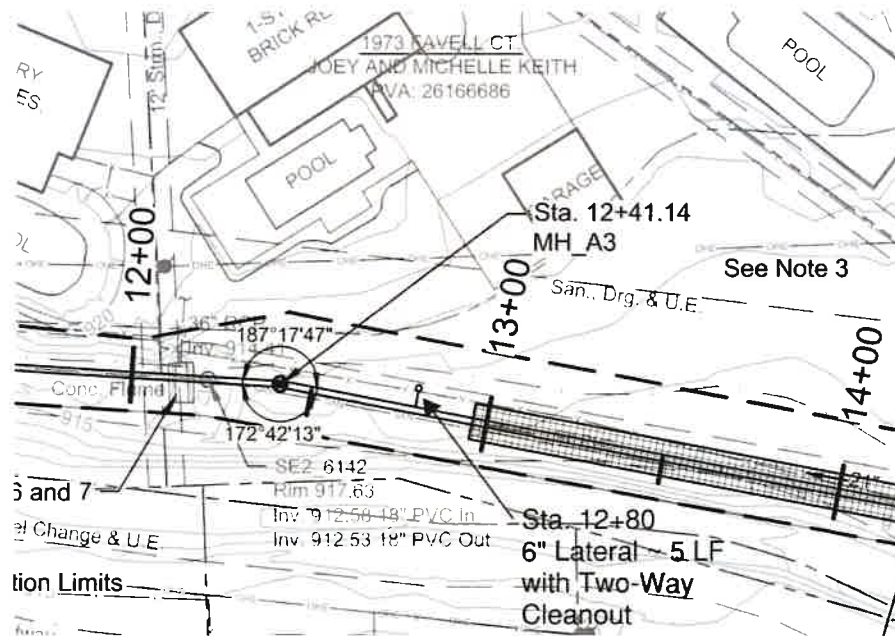


FIGURE 1. PROPOSED LATERAL FOR 1973 FAVELL COURT.

Please be advised of the following clarifications to the above referenced Bid:

1. SPECIFICATIONS: SECTION 00410 – BID SCHEDULE

The Bid Schedule in Part 1.04 has been revised. New items for Remove and Replace Concrete Headwall for 36" Storm Pipe, Remove and Replace Concrete Flume, 6-inch PVC Lateral, and Install Cleanout have been added. The revised specification section 00410 Bid Form is attached and shall be used by Bidders.

2. CLARIFICATIONS

- A. The Contractor may not use the existing, concrete low water crossing (near Sta. 29+00). The bridge is private property and located outside the construction limits.
- B. Project is to be constructed between January 7, 2025 and May 7, 2025 (120 days). (Specification Section 00520-1, Part 1.02 incorrectly indicates 180 days.)
- C. The allowance amount for Miscellaneous Site Improvements is \$150,000.00 and is correct on the Bid Schedule. (Specification Section 01210-1, Part 1.01 incorrectly indicates \$300,000.00.)

3. QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Question #1: Bid items 7 & 8 state 1020' and 984' of 21" Sanitary Sewer Pipe. Can Direct Bury Vylon Pipe be an approved material for the total 2004' of 21" PVC Gravity Sewer Direct Bury applications?

Answer #1: Acceptable pipe materials for sewage collection lines are identified in Section 02532 of the Specifications. Other pipe materials may be approved by LFUCG after a detailed review of pipe properties



available from the manufacturer but is not assured. A detailed review and determination of acceptance for pipe materials not named in the Specifications will not be performed prior to the deadline for submission of bids for this project. Bidders who assume a pipe material not named in the Specifications do so at their own risk.

Question #2: The Drawings indicate that the existing sewer extending between MH-A7 (SE2_6138) and MH-A5 (SE2_6140) is to be abandoned. How is the sewer pipe to be abandoned?

Answer #2: The abandoned sewer is to be cut and capped at both ends (Item #20 in the Bid Schedule). Safeloading of the pipe is not required. Refer to General Construction Note #10 on Drawing C-4.

Question #3: How is the existing manhole SE2_6139 to be abandoned?

Question #3: Manhole frame and top section to be removed and the manhole filled with No. 9 Stone. Refer to the Manhole Abandonment Detail on Drawing No. SD4 and General Construction Note #11 on Drawing C-4.

Question #4: Since some of the contractors had issues getting on the prebid meeting call and didn't hear about the only time to visit the site was directly after the meeting, is it possible to have 1 more site visit for those of us that did not get in the meeting?

Answer #4: No. The site visit information was provided in Addendum No. 2 that was issued on September 30, 2024.

Question #5: Is there a detail on what needs to be installed for the temporary bridge or is this up to the contractor how to do it?

Answer #5: There is no detail for the temporary bridge crossing. The *Creek Crossing Plan – Equipment* submittal (General Note #6 on Drawing C-02) should include a description\sketch of the Contractor's proposed temporary bridge\crossing.


