This MOU will establish an agreement by the Lexington Police Department to provide police canine services to the Winchester police Police Department. agency currently without а canine.There will (L0332-15) be no budgetary impact. (Barnard/Bastin)
- b 0355-15 Authorization to execute an agreement awarding a Class B (Education) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant to the Living Arts and Science Center, Inc., at a total cost not to exceed \$32,851.00. The award will facilitate the development and presentation of curriculum and program activities involving water quality, stormwater issues, and water conservation into the Living Arts and Science Center's programming. Funds are budgeted. (L0355-15)(Martin/Holmes)

- j 0392-15 Authorization to approve Change Order #1 (Final) to LAGCO, Inc reducing the final construction cost of the Anniston-Wickland Phase 3 project to \$989,346.05. This represents a \$5,890.95 decrease of the original bid amount of \$995,237.00. Funds are budgeted. (L0392-15)(Martin/Holmes)
- k 0393-15 Authorization to execute an agreement awarding a Class B (Infrastructure) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant to Link-Belt Construction equipment Company, L.P., LLLP, at a

- Authorization to execute Change Order 1 in the amount of \$194,152 to the contract between the LFUCG and Lagco, Inc., for the Idle Hour Park demolition and football field construction project. Add Alternates #3, 5, 6, and 7 totaling \$118,883 were not funded during the bid and award period. Line items #1,2, and 8 totaling \$52,485 have been precipitated by unanticipated site issues and as a result of the sanitary sewer project which runs through the park. The change order also includes \$27,784 for electrical service for the softball field. New contract total will be \$560,693. Funds are budgeted. (L0400-15)(Reed)
- m 0403-15 Authorization to submit various applications to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet requesting federal funds from the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program. There is no budgetary impact for the submission of applications. Accepting of grant awards wills require 20% local match. (L0403-15)(Gooding/Paulsen)
- n 0404-15 Authorization to accept award of federal funds in the amount of \$30,000 from the Commonwealth Of Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Division of Highway Safety Programs for Distracted Driving Enforcement Services. With these funds, the Division of Police will schedule officers on an overtime basis to conduct distracted driving enforcement. The purpose of this grant is to reduce fatalities on Kentucky roadways and to minimize injuries to the individual and property. A budget amendment is in process. (L0404-15)(Gooding/Bastin)

This equipment was purchased in 2010 for the Hazardous Devices Unit and is no longer compatible with our donation current radio system. This would be for law enforcement use only. The radio equipment is currently being processed for surplus. Upon approval of donation, the radio equipment will be transferred to the Kentucky Sate Police. There will be no budgetary impact.
