Authorization to establish Metals Treatment Technologies (MT2) Firing Range Services as a Sole Source Vendor for lead remediation of the berm at the Police Firearms Range.

Why are you requesting?

For the lead remediation of the berm at the Police Firearms Range, which is required by US EPA. MT2 provides lead maintenance services in accordance with applicable Federal, State, and local safety and environmental regulations. Based upon our reported range usage, as maintained by the Range Officer, MT2 will recover and recycle 10-12 tons of lead from the backstop berms and apron areas. They ensure 80-90% of lead bullets and bullet fragments are removed. MT2 has all certified crews who will restore the berms and clean the range upon completion of reclamation of lead. Documentation, including waste manifests and lead reclamation certificates are provided within 1-2 weeks of project completion. Lead reclamation proceeds offset the cost of services. MT2 guarantees, through their ECOBOND soil treatment process, to meet US EPA Resource Conservation and Recovery Act guidelines of hazardous lead Toxicity Characteristic Leaching Procedure to reduce leachability of lead into surface soils and reduce the potential for lead infiltration to groundwater. Requesting Mayor and Council approval of the attached Sole Source and Proposal.
