SUBJECT Application for Household Hazardous Waste Management Grant Program

Request: Council authorization to submit an application, and accept award if offered, to the Department of Environmental Quality—Division of Waste Management in the amount of \$102,000 for the support of a one-day household hazardous waste recycling event for Fayette County, the acceptance of which obligates the government to provide match in the amount of \$25,500.

Purpose of Request: The Division of Waste Management has prepared an application for submission to the state agency requesting funds for support of a one-day countywide household waste recycling event. Funds will be used to contract with a vendor for appropriate disposal of hazardous waste. The Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste Grants Program was established in 2006 by Senate Bill 50. KRS 224.43-505 (2)(c) specifies the establishment of a Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste management grants program.

Cost in this budget year and future budget years: State funds in the amount of \$102,000 will be budgeted in Fiscal Year 2023. If grant is awarded, a match is required in FY23 in the amount of \$25,500 in the Urban Services Funds (Fund 1115). Total cost will be \$127,500. No expenses are anticipated for future budget years.

Are funds budgeted? A budget amendment will be completed if approved.
