If the period of liability exceeds 48 hours, the insured loss or damage will be calculated based upon the amount of such loss in excess of the waiting period, subject to a minimum deductible of \$250,000 combined for all coverages. Any period in which business operations or services would have not been maintained, or any period in which goods would have not been produced will not be included as part of or serve to reduce the effect of any waiting period.

B. Computer Systems Non-Physical Damage:

In the event of loss resulting from the failure of the Insured's electronic data processing or media to operate as a direct result of a malicious act directed at the named Insured, no coverage is provided unless the period of liability exceeds 48 hours beginning from the time of insured loss or damage. The company's liability commences only after, and does not include, the waiting period specified.

If the period of liability exceeds 48 hours, the insured loss or damage will be calculated based upon the amount of such loss in excess of the waiting period, subject to a minimum deductible of \$250,000 combined for all coverages.

Any period in which business operations or services would have not been maintained, or any period in which goods would have not been produced will not be included as part of or serve to reduce the effect of any waiting period.

Motor Vehicle Coverage: On property insured under this coverage, the loss amount will not exceed the actual cash value.

2. Traffic Control Equipment

This Policy covers insured physical loss or damage to Traffic Control Equipment while at a location, including while in transit.

- 1) References and Application: The following term(s) wherever used in this Policy Meants:
 - a) Traffic Control Equipment: Traffic Control Equipment owned by the Insured and described on a schedule on file with the Company.
- 3. Pavement and Roadways Described Location This policy is extended to cover insured property for Pavements and Roadways at a described location only.
- 4. <u>Transmission and Distribution Systems Exclusion</u> PROPERTY EXCLUDED is amended to include: Transmission and distribution systems, including poles, towers and fixtures, overhead conductors and devices, underground or underwater conduit, underground or underwater conductors and devices, line transformers, service meters, street lighting and signal systems.
- 5. <u>Animals Coverage</u> Coverage provided by this policy is extended to include physical loss or damage to animals while at described locations.

PROPERTY EXCLUDED, item 2., is amended to: Growing Crops or standing timber.

Animals Coverage Exclusion: As respects Animals Coverage, the following additional exclusions apply:

This Policy excludes animal mortality, including any physical injury or death caused by other animals, unless directly caused by named perils.

Animal Coverage Valuation: On property covered under this coverage, the loss amount will not exceed the lesser of:

- a. The cost to replace the animal with a similar species of animal; or
- b. The value designated for the animal in the most recent statement of values submitted by the Insured; or
- c. The sub-limit for animals.

6. <u>Historical Replacement Cost</u>

LOSS ADJUSTMENT AND SETTLEMENT item L., Valuation, is amended to include:

With respect to buildings designated by a local, state, or federal authority to be of historical significance or of historical value, such rebuilding, repairing or replacement shall be with modern material, workmanship processes, technologies and designs, and shall not include the cost of re-creating outdated, archaic or antiquated materials, workmanship, processes, technologies, or designs, whether or not such cost otherwise would be covered under Section D.ADDITIONAL PROPERTY DAMAGE COVERAGE, Item 10., Demolition and Increased Cost of Construction.

7. United States Certified Act of Terrorism 2015

As respects the United States, its territories and possessions and the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the definition of terrorism contained in DEFINITIONS is declared null and void and it is agreed that an event defined as a Certified Act of Terrorism under the terms of the SUPPLEMENTAL UNITED STATES CERTIFIED ACT OF TERRORISM ENDORSEMENT attached to this Policy shall be considered terrorism within the terms of this policy. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Policy to the contrary, this Policy provides coverage for direct physical loss or damage to insured property and any resulting Business Interruption loss, as provided in the Policy, caused by or resulting from a Certified Act of Terrorism only to the extent coverage is provided under the terms and conditions of the SUPPLEMENTAL UNITED STATES CERTIFIED ACT OF TERRORISM ENDORSEMENT attached to this policy. Any difference in limit between loss recoverable under the SUPPLEMENTAL UNITED STATES CERTIFIED ACT OF TERRORISM ENDORSEMENT and this Policy is not recoverable under this Policy.







- Property Damage and Business Interruption Coverages: Are now arranged alphabetically.
- * Additional Coverages: Grants of coverage and related terms and conditions are contained within the additional coverage itself.
- "165 Lines" is now included in the policy wording (US and Canada Only): In an effort to make the provision as clear and easy to use as possible, the 165 Lines, which was previously attached to the policy, is now included in the policy.
 - Abandonment has been brought into Loss Adjustment & Settlement
 - Appraisal has been brought into Loss Adjustment & Settlement
 - Company Option has been brought into Loss Adjustment & Settlement
 - Requirements in Case of Loss has been brought into Loss Adjustment and Settlement

Coverage Changes

There are changes to many areas of the policy. To keep this document concise and focused, we have limited its scope to the most significant changes. Please see the policy for all coverage wordings.

Restriction in Coverage

The proVision has two new restrictions. These restrictions were added to enhance contract certainty that these types of property exposures are ones that need to be underwritten on a case-by-case basis. If clients have this type of exposure and need coverage, we will work with you to try to find an underwriting solution.

- Off-Shore Property: Property while located offshore, except as provided by transit coverage. Because our Unnamed Location provides coverage for a very large policy territory, we could be picking up off-shore property unintentionally. In the rare case your insured has this type of exposure, please discuss with your underwriter.
- Transmission and Distribution Systems (T&D): Unnamed locations now includes a T&D Systems Exclusion. By not excluding this in past forms we were picking up T&D systems, wherever located. In the past when insureds had this type of exposure, we added a "Transmission and Distribution Systems Exclusion" to the declarations section of the policy. To ensure consistency, this exclusion has been brought into the proVision 4100 policy to enhance contract certainty, not to broadly provide this type of coverage.

New Coverage

- Computer Systems Non-Physical Damage: This extends business interruption coverage loss due to failure of the insured's electronic data processing (EDP) equipment or media to operate as a direct result of a malicious act directed at the named insured.
- Protection and Preservation of Property: This includes coverage for fire department charges (firefighting materials and expenses, metered water) without a sublimit. It also adds coverage for security charges for 30 days. Now includes business interruption as part of the coverage.

Expansion and/or Consolidation of Existing Coverage

- * Arson or Theft Reward: Recovery no longer limited to 10% of loss.
- **Attraction Property:** Coverage has been expanded to one mile from an insured's location.
- Brands & Labels: Are now covered to the policy limit. Coverage has been improved by including coverage "at this Company's expense" vs. "at insured's own" expense.
- Change of Temperature: Coverage for spoilage of stock and supplies due to change of temperature stemming from an accidental interruption of services at a location is now provided to all insureds.
- Delay in Startup: Coverage is now included as part of the period of liability with no specific sublimit.
- Demolition and Increased Cost of Construction (DICC): Now includes coverage for machinery and equipment.
- **Earth Movement**: Earth movement deductibles now only apply to damage caused by earthquake.
- **Expediting Expense**: Now includes temporary replacement of insured property.
- **Extended Period of Liability (EPL)**: Previously named Extended Period of Indemnity (EPI) now includes coverage for rental income and the default limit has been increased to 90 days.
- **Exterior Insulation & Finishing System (EIFS)**: The exclusion for failure or malfunction of (EIFS) has been removed from the policy.
- Fine Arts: Coverage now included when items are in transit. Pairs & Sets provision now applies to Fine Arts.
- Insured Option: Previously referred to as BI select. The insured now has the option of choosing between gross earnings and gross profits after a loss.
- Off-Premises Service Interruption (OPSI)-Property Damage and Business Interruption: Coverage has been added for voice, data and video.
- Ordinary Payroll: Is now included in Gross Earnings and Gross Profits coverage.
- Personal Property:
 - Coverage extended to owned property; improvements and betterments; property of others in the insured's custody and obligation to insure or legally liable.
 - Coverage has been extended to include a defense provision.
 - Warehouse/Bailee: The exclusion for this coverage was removed, except when acting as a common or contract carrier.
- Supply Chain: Replaces contingent business interruption coverage. Provides coverage for named and unnamed, direct and indirect suppliers and customers. Coverage has been added for commissions, profits and royalties.
- **Tax Treatment**: Coverage was added for the profit portion of finished stock.
- Transit: Business interruption is now included for property in transit.
- **Vacancy or Unoccupied Locations**: There is no longer a vacancy restriction on the policy.

Segment Form Endorsements

This is a summary of the unique coverage added by our segment endorsements.

Condominium Endorsement:

- Condominium Maintenance Fees: Covers the actual loss of condominium maintenance fees that the insured is unable to collect as a direct result of insured physical loss or damage to insured property.
- Contingent Property: Covers Real Property that is the contractual responsibility of the insured's lessee to insure when the lessee fails to maintain the insurance or the insurance is uncollectible due to the insolvency of the lessee's insurer.
- Down Zoning and Rezoning: Provides coverage when the insured is prohibited from repairing, replacing or rebuilding to the same height, floor area, number of units, configuration, occupancy or operating capacity, as a direct result of the enforcement of any law or ordinance.
- **Emergency Evacuation Expense**: Covers the cost to evacuate tenants and residents at management discretion or when a civil authority orders the emergency evacuation due to immediately impending or actual physical loss or damage.
- **Tenant Relocation Expense**: Covers relocation expenses when rented space or living quarters are made uninhabitable following direct physical loss or damage.

Education Endorsement:

- **Emergency Evacuation Expense**: Covers the cost to evacuate tenants and residents at management discretion or when a civil authority orders the emergency evacuation due to immediately impending or actual physical loss or damage.
- Fund Raising Expense: Covers the fixed charges and expenses of a fund raising activity or event that is cancelled or postponed because of insured physical loss or damage.
- Prizes and Giveaways: Covers motor vehicles and watercraft that are prizes or giveaways in the insured's fund raising activities or events.
- Professional Employee Replacement Expense: Covers expenses incurred by the insured to replace administrators, professors, teachers and research personnel who have resigned following physical loss or damage when the Period of Liability exceeds 30 consecutive days.
- Research and Development Animals and Experiments: Covers research animals, research experiments including project restoration costs.
- Students and Teachers Personal Property: Extends the personal property coverage in the policy to include students' and teachers' personal property whether or not in the insured's custody or control.
- **Students and Teachers Relocation Expense**: Covers student and teacher relocation expenses when rooms or rented space are made uninhabitable following direct physical loss or damage.
- Tuition and Fees: Amends the business interruption coverage to include the immediately preceding school term if the
 damaged property is restored and period of liability contained in the proVision 4100 ends within 30 days of the start of the
 school term.

Healthcare Endorsement:

- Change of Temperature: Covers loss caused by a change in temperature resulting from an accidental event at a location. This is broader than the coverage provided under the proVision 4100.
- Communicable Disease Cleanup, Removal and Disposal: Covers the cleanup, removal and disposal of a communicable disease and the expenses to restore the property as a result of the enforcement of any law or ordinance.
- **Emergency Evacuation Expense**: Covers the cost to evacuate patients and residents when a civil authority orders the emergency evacuation because of immediately impending or actual physical loss.
- Fund Raising Expense: Covers the fixed charges and expenses of a fund raising activity or event that is cancelled or postponed because of insured physical loss or damage.
- Mobile Medical and Diagnostic Equipment: Covers mobile medical equipment, diagnostic equipment and their associated supplies, including owned, leased and operated licensed vehicles in which such property is contained, while not at a described location.
- Patient and Tenant Relocation Expense: Covers patient and tenant relocation expenses when the room is made uninhabitable following direct physical loss or damage.
- Patients' Personal Property: Extends the personal property coverage in the policy to include patient's personal property
 whether or not in the insured custody or control.
- Prizes and Giveaways: Covers real and personal property, including motor vehicles and watercraft that are prizes or giveaways in the insured's fund raising activities or events.
- **Professional Employee Replacement Expense**: Covers expenses incurred by the insured to replace professional employees who have resigned following physical loss or damage to insured property when the Period of Liability resulting exceeds 30 consecutive days.
- Removal and Restocking Expense: Covers expenses incurred by the insured for complying with the recall of a pharmaceutical product or medical supply that the insured sells. The recall must be required by the product's manufacturer or by order of governmental authority.
- Research and Development Animals and Experiments: Covers research animals, research experiments including project restoration costs.

Master Policy Endorsement

- Master Global Insuring Policy: Covers the difference in limits, definitions, perils, conditions or coverage between the local policy and the proVision 4100 master policy.
- **Coinsurance Deficiency and Currency Devaluation**: Covers the deficiency in the amount of loss payable under locally written policies solely as the result of a coinsurance (or average) clause or official government devaluation of the currency in which the local policy is written.
- Increased Tax Liability: Allows for additional payment to offset increased tax liability if a loss payment cannot be paid in the country where the loss occurred.
- Neighbor's Recourse and Tenant's Liability: Covers the insured's liability as a tenant or occupant under any civil or commercial code for physical loss or damage to property of a neighbor, co-tenant and other third parties within France, Spain, Italy, Belgium, Greece, Portugal and Luxembourg.
- **Transit**: Covers transit on a worldwide basis.

Real Estate

- Contingent Property: Covers Real Property that is the contractual responsibility of the insured's lessee to insure when the lessee fails to maintain the insurance or the insurance is uncollectible due to the insolvency of the lessee's insurer.
- **Down Zoning and Rezoning Coverage**: Provides coverage when the insured is prohibited from repairing, replacing or rebuilding to the same height, floor area, number of units, configuration, occupancy or operating capacity, as a direct result of the enforcement of any law or ordinance.
- **Emergency Evacuation Expense**: Covers the cost to evacuate residents and tenants at management discretion or when a civil authority orders the emergency evacuation due to immediately impending or actual physical loss or damage.
- Inn Keeper's Liability: Extends the personal property coverage in the policy to include hotel guests' personal property whether or not in the insured's custody or control.
- Tenant Relocation Expense: Covers tenant relocation expenses when the room is made uninhabitable following direct physical loss or damage.

Retail Endorsement

- Change of Temperature: Covers loss caused by a change in temperature resulting from an accidental event at a location. This is broader than the coverage provided under the proVision 4100.
- Removal and Restocking Expenses: Covers expenses incurred by the insured for complying with the recall of a product that the insured sells. The recall must be required by the product's manufacturer or by order of governmental authority.
- Valuation: Values all merchandise to selling price.

Contract Certainty Improvements

One of the goals with the rewrite of the proVision was enhanced contract certainty, while making it easier to use, navigate and understand. As a result, the proVision 4100 incorporates many changes aimed to increase the reader's understanding of coverages—which means an even greater degree of transparency and contract certainty.

Modifications

- ► Contractors and Subcontractors: The policy also insures the interests of contractors and subcontractors in the insured property during construction to the extent our insured has agreed to insure these interests. This interest does not include any business interruption.
- Policy Jacket: A clear statement of All-Risk Coverage insuring described property, except as excluded, while located as described in this policy.
- Property Insured: The wording has been revised to state "to the extent" that the insured has insurable interest.
- Real Property:
 - Previously we listed items that were examples of real property. As this was not an all-inclusive list, it was deleted to improve contract certainty.
 - There is no longer the "all if not covered by other insurance" wording.

Exclusions:

- Group I, II and III Exclusions: For clarification purposes, exclusions have been restructured.
- Contamination: Is covered as a result of other insured physical damage.

Loss Adjustment and Settlement

- **Collection from Others:** New clause-expressed actual loss sustained principle for property damage. The Company will not be liable for any loss to the extent that the insured has collected for such loss from others.
- Loss Adjustment & Payable: Confirms with whom the loss will be adjusted and payable including third-party interests.
- **Mortgagee/Lenders Loss Payable:** Wording was amended so addition of a mortgagee/lenders loss payable clause to the declarations page of our policy is no longer needed.
- Requirements in Case of Loss: Consolidates several items from the 165 Lines, including requirements to give notice, protect from further damage, etc., as well as file a Proof of Loss.
