SUBJECT: Grant Award from Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet for Street Sales Drug Enforcement Project at the Division of Police

Request: Authorization to accept award from the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet in the amount of 30,000 for the continuation of the Street Sales Drug Enforcement Project for FY 2024. Match in the amount of \$13,684 has been budgeted, for total project cost of \$43,684.

Purpose of Request: The Division of Police submitted a grant application to the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet requesting federal funding for continuation of the Street Sales Drug Enforcement project for Fiscal Year 2024. The Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet has awarded \$30,000 in federal funds to continue the activities of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government's Division of Police. Match in the amount of \$13,684 has been budgeted for program operation for a total project cost of \$43,684. The source of these federal funds is the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program in the U.S. Department of Justice.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? Cost in FY24 is \$43,684. Federal funds in the amount of \$30,000 and local match of \$13,684. Future years funding is dependent upon availability of grant funding.

Are the funds budgeted? FY2024 budget amendment was completed for ST_SALES_2024.
