RE: **Emerson Network Power Contract – Uninterruptable Power Supply (Battery Replacement)**

Please find attached Emerson Network Power Renewal Contract for service of the uninterruptible power system that backs up Communications and Police Headquarters.

Emerson Network Power is a sole source vendor, in which, the battery replacement for the uninterruptible power supply (UPS) is purchased. The uninterruptible power supply located in the main computer room to the E911 Center is responsible for providing power to the Division of Police server farm, AS400, radio voting receivers and E911 equipment in the event of a power failure. The UPS is designed to hold power up for the aforementioned equipment until the emergency generator starts and delivers the necessary power for the equipment to continue operating until normal power is restored. The attached contract is for one (1) year, December 2013 – December 2014.
