

RESOLUTION NO. 353-2015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE LAW FIRM OF FROST BROWN TODD, LLC, ACTING BY AND THROUGH W. JOSEPH SCHOLLER, FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE DIVISIONS OF COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS AND FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$80,000.

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized to execute the Professional Services Agreement, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, with the law firm of Frost Brown Todd, LLC, acting by and through W. Joseph Scholler, for collective bargaining negotiations with the Divisions of Community Corrections and Fire and Emergency Services.

Section 2 - That an amount, not to exceed the sum of \$80,000.00, be and hereby is approved for payment to Frost Brown Todd, LLC from account # 1101-160501-71299, pursuant to the terms of the Agreement.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.


RE: Collective Bargaining Services

Council approval is sought for the attached Professional Services Agreement with the law firm of Frost Brown Todd, LLC and attorney Joe Scholler for negotiating 3 collective bargaining agreements.

The Department of Law has preliminarily retained the services of Joe Scholler with Frost Brown Todd to assist in the negotiation of the Collective Bargaining Agreements with the Division of Community Corrections (Officers and Sergeants and Lieutenants and Captains) and the Division of Fire and Emergency Services (Fire Majors). Mr. Scholler and his firm have previously assisted LFUCG with similar agreements, and his firm is on the approved list for this type of legal work.

The total cost of the agreement is \$80,000.00 with all funds budgeted from account 1101-160501-1911-71299 in FY 2015.
