

SUBJECT: REQUEST COUNCIL AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE
SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 1 WITH THE KENTUCKY
TRANSPORTATION CABINET FOR DESIGN AND
CONSTRUCTION OF ISAAC MURPHY MEMORIAL GARDEN

On February 11, 2010 (Ordinance No. 25-2010), the Urban County Council authorized acceptance of state funds in the amount of \$177,350 from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) for the construction of infrastructure improvements for the Isaac Murphy Memorial Garden near Midland Avenue and Third Street.

KYTC has offered the LFUCG Supplemental Agreement No. 1 which will allow the LFUCG to use \$117,902.25 in grant funds as match for the Legacy Trail Enhancements Project, a federally funded project from the Federal Highway Administration under the Transportation, Community, and System Preservation Program (TCSP).

Council authorization to approve execution of the Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for the Isaac Murphy Memorial Garden project is hereby requested.
