REQUEST COUNCIL AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE CONSTRUCTION RIGHT OF ENTRY ACREEMENT WITH

CONSTRUCTION RIGHT OF ENTRY AGREEMENT WITH NORFOLK SOUTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY FOR THE

SOUTHLAND DRIVE BIKE LANE PROJECT

On October 21, 2010 (Ordinance No. 185-2010), Council approved acceptance of federal funds from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for construction of the Southland Drive Bike Lane Project, from Nicholasville Road to Rosemont Garden.

The project will add bike lanes and a sidewalk underneath the Norfolk Southern overpass on Southland Drive. In order to get right of entry, Norfolk Southern Railway Company has requested that Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government execute Construction Right of Entry Agreement in the amount of \$42,400.
