Recycling Grant program

Request:

Council authorization is requested to submit an application, and accept award if offered, to the Department of Environmental Quality—Division of Waste Management in the amount of \$83,000 for the support of advertising expenses related to recycling.

Purpose of Request:

The Division of Waste Management has prepared an application for submission to the state agency requesting funds for support of an advertising campaign designed to increase recycling rates. The Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste Grants Program was established in 2006 by Senate Bill 50. KRS 224.43-505 (2)(c) specifies the establishment of a Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste management grants program.

Cost in this budget year and future budget years:

State funds in the amount of \$83,000 will be budgeted in Fiscal Year 2017. A match of \$20,750 will be budgeted in the Urban Services Funds (Fund 1115). Total cost will be \$103,750. No expenses are anticipated for future budget years.

Are funds budgeted? Budget amendments for Fiscal Year 2017 are in process.
