RE: Tyler Technologies – Amendment to Agreement

Request:

The Division of Enhanced 911 is requesting authorization for the Mayor to sign an amendment to the current agreement with Tyler Technologies that is detailed in resolution 598-2017.

Why are you requesting?

E911, Lexington Police Department and the Division of Fire and Emergency Services have been working with Tyler Technologies to deploy a new Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD), Mobile and Records services which will be utilized for dispatching, updating and reporting upon public safety calls for service. This project has been underway since September 2017 and while much work has been accomplished, several milestones are still outstanding. The attached amendment voids an earlier Tyler invoice of \$238,443.67. It also outlines the cost of maintenance upon "go-live" of the new software as well as the maintenance cost of legacy Tyler software already in use by E911 and Lexington Police. There is no increase to the cost of the software or services outlined in the original agreement.
