## RESOLUTION NO. 288 -2013

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE KENTUCKY JUSTICE AND PUBLIC SAFETY CABINET, WHICH GRANT FUNDS ARE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,246,560.00 COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY FUNDS, ARE FOR POLICE TRAINING INCENTIVE FUNDS, THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH DOES NOT OBLIGATE THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED FUNDS WITHIN THE GRANT BUDGET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a Grant from the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$2,246,560.00 Commonwealth of Kentucky funds, are for police training incentive funds, and the acceptance of which does not obligate the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget established herein.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.

REQUEST COUNCIL AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT AWARD FOR POLICE TRAINING INCENTIVE GRANT FOR FY 2014 FROM THE KENTUCKY JUSTICE AND PUBLIC SAFETY CABINET UNDER THE KENTUCKY LAW ENFORCEMENT FOUNDATION PROGRAM FUND

Police Training Incentive funds are used to provide eligible police officers with supplemental pay for participation in training programs. Supplemental pay in the amount of \$3,100.00 for each eligible officer (555 sworn positions) is provided for a total of \$1,720,500. In addition, the program contributes 30.5758% of that total towards the pension of participants, totaling 526,060. Funds total \$2,246,560 with no local match required. Funds are from the state of Kentucky and are awarded by the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet from the Kentucky Law Enforcement Foundation Program Fund.
