**SUBJECT: Amendment to Agreement with Sunflower Kids, Inc.**

**Request:**

Council authorization to execute Amendment to Agreement with Sunflower Kids, Inc. extending the period of performance through September 30, 2018 for provision of supervised visitation and safe exchange services for victims of domestic violence, child abuse, sexual assault, and stalking.

**Purpose of Request:**

On October 24, 2013 (Resolution 558-2013), Council approved acceptance of federal funds from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women for continuation of a Safe Havens project and approved execution of an agreement with Sunflower Kids, Inc. for provision of supervised visitation and monitored exchange services.

On October 13, 2016 (Resolution 617-2016), Council approved execution of amendment to agreement with Sunflower Kids extending the period of performance through September 30, 2017. The U.S. Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women has awarded a one-year extension to the Safe Havens grant. An extension to the agreement with Sunflower Kids, Inc. is needed.

**What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?**

There is no additional cost in this fiscal year. Costs in in future budget years are dependent upon award of additional federal funds.
