SUBJECT: Authorization to execute an amendment to Supplemental Agreement #1 with the

Kentucky Transportation Cabinet to support execution of the TIGER

Amendment No. 3 agreement for Town Branch Commons

Request: Council authorization to authorize and direct the Mayor to execute an amendment to Supplemental Agreement #1 with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet incorporating the budget and scope of work for the approved U.S. Department of Transportation Amendment No. 3 of the TIGER grant for the Town Branch Commons Project and allowing pass through of funds to LFUCG.

Purpose of Request: On December 6, 2016 (Resolution 730-2016), Council approved the acceptance of \$14,095,997 of federal funds and authorized the expenditure of \$3,523,972 as match for the Town Branch Commons Project. On December 14, 2017 (Resolution No. 763-2017), Council approved the execution of the grant agreement between the city and the U.S. Department of Transportation. On August 29, 2019 (Resolution 475-2019), Council approved Amendment No. 1 to update project schedule and estimated project budget for all zones. On July 7, 2020 (Resolution 296-2020), Council approved Amendment No. 2 to modify the statement of work, schedule and budget. On September 30, 2021(Resolution 536-2021), Council approved Amendment No. 3 to the TIGER agreement to modify the budget.

Federal TIGER funds, while awarded to the LFUCG directly, must pass through the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet. This Supplemental Agreement creates the legal mechanism for that pass through of funds. It is an administrative agreement requested by the Cabinet with no financial impact.
