REQUEST COUNCIL AUTHORIZATION TO APPROVE CORRECTION TO RESOLUTION NO. 90-2012 CORRECTING MAXIMUM AMOUNT TO BE PAID TO TACTICAL ENERGETIC ENTRY SYSTEM, LLC, FROM \$35,000 TO \$39,500 FOR DYNAMIC ENTRY TRAINING FOR THE DIVISION OF

POLICE UNDER-BID #129-2011

On February 23, 2012 (Resolution No. 90-2012), Council approved execution of agreement with Tactical Energetic Entry System, LLC, for provision of dynamic entry training in the amount of \$35,000 for 25 students and \$900 each for up to an additional five students. The resolution provided for payment for the first 25 students in the amount of \$35,000. Division of Police has elected to have five additional persons trained, at a cost of \$4,500, for a total contract cost of \$39,500.
