SUBJECT: Request for a portion of NPE Mitigation remnant right-of-way and easement closures

Request Authorization for:

The closure of LFUCG right-of-way and abandon/dissolve the existing easement within a portion of the Mitigation Area for the Newtown Pike Extension Project. Please see attached Exhibit for location.

Department needs this action completed because:

The mitigation efforts associated with the Newtown Pike Extension require the project to redevelop the mitigation area in accordance with the Project Environmental Impact Statement. The streets to be closed are a portion of DeRoode Street from the intersection of McKinley Street to its intersection with Patterson Street, a portion of Patterson Street at the end of the far end of the street, a portion of Merino Street from the intersection of Combs Alley south to its end, a portion of McKinley Street from the intersection of Merino Street to DeRoode Street, all of Byars Avenue, all of Neville Street and dissolve all existing easements within the limits as shown on the attached Exhibit (*Existing LFUCG Right of Way to Close – January 15, 2016*). LFUCG Division Directors and utility company representatives have been advised and have consented to this request. New right-of-way and easements will be dedicated with the filing of the final record plat for this area.
