# Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a FY19 (Class B Education) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for The University of Kentucky Research Foundation (UKRF) in the amount of \$35,000.00.

### Purpose of Request

The purpose of this project is to educate and involve the public about the effects of excess phosphorous (P) on the Commonwealth's surface waters. A goal of this project is to create a paradigm shift in current lawn fertilizing habits, resulting in nutrient load reduction that will ultimately improve water quality. UKRF seeks to develop educational materials that can be provided to pet-oriented businesses / organizations and to professional associations, and that can be disseminated at public events and included on signage at LFUCG dog parks.

### Project Cost in FY19 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$35,000.00 and will be fully spent by FY20.
