

RESOLUTION NO. 614 - 2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF FEDERAL FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, THROUGH THE CHEMICAL STOCKPILE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PROGRAM (CSEPP), IN A SUM NOT TO EXCEED \$242,967.00 IN FY 2022, TO MANAGEMENT REGISTRY, INC., (F/K/A OMNISOURCE INTEGRATED SUPPLY, LLC), TO FUND CSEPP SUPPORT STAFF, AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY AGREEMENTS, INCLUDING AMENDMENTS THERETO, WITH MANAGEMENT REGISTRY, INC., (F/K/A OMNISOURCE INTEGRATED SUPPLY, LLC) RELATED TO THE USE OF THESE FUNDS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 – That an amount, not to exceed the sum of \$242,967.00 in federal funds, which was received from the Kentucky Department of Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Management, through the Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP) is hereby approved for payment to Management Registry, Inc., (f/k/a OmniSource Integrated Supply, LLC), from account # 3200-505201-71299, pursuant to the terms of an Agreement with Management Registry, Inc., which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, to fund CSEPP support staff for FY 2022.

Section 2 – That the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, is hereby authorized and directed to execute any necessary agreements, including amendments thereto, with Management Registry, Inc., (f/k/a OmniSource Integrated Supply, LLC), related to use of these funds.

Section 3 -- That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
