A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT #3 TO THE AGREEMENT WITH BLUEGRASS AREA DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FEDERAL FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,503.00, FOR OPERATION OF THE LEXINGTON SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute Amendment #3, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, to the agreement with Bluegrass Area Development District, providing for additional Federal funds in the amount of \$11,503.00 for operation of the Lexington Senior Citizens Center.

Section 2 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.

On April 26, 2012 (Resolution No. 202-2012), Council approved acceptance of federal funds in the amount of \$83,101 for operation of the Lexington Senior Citizens Center in FY 2013 under Title III of the Older Americans Act.


On April 11, 2013 (Resolution No. 155-2013), Council authorized execution of Amendment # 1 to the agreement in the amount of \$5,256, providing a new total of \$88,357.

Council is in process of approving Amendment # 2 in the amount of \$10,040 in federal funds for a new total of \$98,397.

Bluegrass Area Development District has offered Amendment # 3 in the amount of \$11,503 in federal funds for operation of the Lexington Senior Citizens Center in FY 2013 for a new total of \$109,900.

The Lexington Senior Citizens Center is a multi-purpose community focal point for services to persons 60 and older in Fayette County. Basic center operations include advocacy, counseling, education, health promotion, access to legal assistance, outreach, recreation, and telephone reassurance.

Council authorization to execute Amendment # 3 is hereby requested.
