Administrative Synopsis - New Business Items

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Authorization to submit an application, and accept award in the amount of \$79,000, to the Kentucky Department of Education/Division of School and Community Nutrition for participation in the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Child Care Food Program for provision of breakfast, lunch, and supplements at free and reduced rates to infants and toddlers attending the Family Care Center's child care and pre-school programs. While no match is required, an additional \$113,500 is budgeted to cover catering costs that exceed actual reimbursement. (L0765-24) (Horton-Holt/Allen-Byant)
