Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency, requesting federal funds in the amount of \$12,827 for a Fire

Prevention Project

The Division of Fire and Emergency Services has prepared a grant application for submission to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency requesting federal funds in the amount of \$12,827 for the 2014 Fire Prevention and Safety Grant for a fire prevention outreach program directed at pre-school through high school aged children.

Funds are requested for purchase of a trailer designed to accommodate large screen televisions and audio visual components to provide for home and fire safety outreach messages to preschools, schools, day care centers, parks, and city-wide events. The trailer will be equipped with a satellite system enabling linking up "on location" with all the educational resources available on the web.

The total project cost is \$14,252. The required local match of 10% (\$1,425) is budgeted in the 2015 General Fund budget for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services.

Council authorization to submit the application is hereby requested.
