SUBJECT: KYTC Agreement for Elizabeth Street Sidewalks Project —Design Phase

Request: Council authorization to accept federal funds in the amount of \$100,000 for the design phase of Elizabeth Street Sidewalks Project as funded under the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Office of Local Programs Transportation Alternatives Program.

Purpose of the Request: The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has awarded the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government federal funds from the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) for the design of sidewalks along both sides of Elizabeth Street between Waller Avenue and Transcript Avenue. This narrow corridor is heavily travelled by UK students.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has offered the LFUCG funds for design phase in the amount of \$100,000. Local match in the amount of \$25,000 is required for a total project cost of \$125,000.

The cost in this budget year and future budget years: Design Cost in FY 2017: \$125,000 (\$100,000 federal funds and \$25,000 local match).

Are the funds budgeted? Budget Amendment #8248 is in process.
