



SUBJECT: Railroad License #NS175257 Termination Agreement

Request

The Division of Water Quality (DWQ) requests a resolution authorizing termination of a railroad license agreement #NS175257 that was not utilized.

Purpose of Request

To terminate a railroad license agreement for a sanitary sewer line that was not built, and no future sewer lines within the railroad easement are necessary to provide service to the area—see attached map. Without the proposed termination agreement from the railroad, LFUCG will continue to be charged an annual fee.

Project Cost in FY18 and in Future Budget Years

None—unless the license agreement is not cancelled then the annual fee will be \$485.00.
