SUBJECT: Master Sewer Service Agreement Amendment

Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District

Request

On behalf of the Jessamine County Fiscal Court, the Jessamine County Public School System and the Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District (JSEWD), the Division of Water Quality recommends approval of an amendment to the <u>Master Sewer Service Agreement</u> between JSEWD and LFUCG.

Purpose of Request

In April of this year, Jessamine County officials approached LFUCG with a proposal to amend the existing sewer service agreement. The proposed amendment would:

- Maintain the current maximum capacity allocation of 2.0 million gallons per day based on a 12 month moving average, and
- Modify the existing service area boundary to include a 127.5 acre tract of land south of Ashgrove Pike. The
 Jessamine County School Board wants to construct a new middle school campus on this parcel. A future
 elementary school is a possibility as well.

Project Cost in FY21 and in Future Budget Years

There is no additional cost to LFUCG.
