SUBJECT: Windstream Agreement – Circuits to Relocate Selective Router and Controller

Request:

The Division of Enhanced 911 is requesting a resolution authorizing the Mayor to approve seven (7) new circuits at the Public Safety Operations Center (PSOC).

Why are you requesting?

E911 intends to move a Selective Router and Controller that handle 911 calls for Lexington and the Central Kentucky 911 Network from the Fire HQ facility we previously occupied to the Public Safety Operations Center. This will allow for ease of maintenance and access in a more secure facility. To move this hardware, telephone circuits must be ordered and installed in advance. After the hardware is moved, the circuits at Fire HQ will be cancelled. There will be a few months of overlapping expenses until the existing circuits are cancelled and E911 is prepared to meet those expenses.

What are the costs in this budget year and future budget years?

FY18 = \$1,750 monthly / total \$21,000 annually

Are the funds budgeted?

Yes.
