SUBJECT: Execution of a software agreement with Home for Life Design for the HUD

Older Adult Home Modification Program

Request: Council authorization to execute a software agreement with Home for Life Design, a software program that is used for the HUD Older Adult Home Modification Program. The government received an award of federal funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Office of Lead Hazard Control and Healthy Homes in the amount of \$2,000,000 for this program.

Purpose of Request: Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, in partnership with Bluegrass Care Navigators, will use the Home for Life Design software to make assessments for clients applying for assistance with the Older Adult Home Modification Grant Program from the Office of Lead Hazard Control and Healthy Homes. This will be a new program offering safe and functional home modifications for seniors in our community. The annual cost of the software will not exceed \$5,000 per year for the three-year grant, for a total not to exceed \$15,000.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? \$15,000. \$5,000 annually for the 3 years of the federal award. No match is required for this grant.
