D. SPECIFICATIONS FOR NUISANCE ABATEMENT MOWING AND CLEANUP SERVICES

1.0 SCOPE AND CLASSIFICATION

These specifications describe requirements of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for mowing and/or cleanup of vacant lots, parklands and other areas including private properties. These mowing and/or cleanup services will be performed as part of the Nuisance Abatement Program per the Ordinances which govern this program.

2.0 PUBLICATIONS

No Publications apply to these specifications.

3.0 REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1 Contractor shall mow vacant lots and other areas designated by the Urban County Government on an "as-needed" basis.
- 3.2 Contractor shall supply to the Urban County Government's designated representative an estimate of expenses required to perform the services described herein if the total expense for providing those services for a specific lot are expected to exceed \$500.00.
- 3.3 Contractor shall remove debris (bottles, rocks, etc.) as may be necessary to prepare designated lots for mowing. If debris exists that Contractor cannot remove with normal tools and workforce, he/she shall contact the Urban County Government before proceeding with work.
- 3.4 Contractor may be required to remove litter and debris only; mowing will not be required in all cases.
- 3.5 Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials and equipment required to perform services described herein.
- 3.6 Contractor shall be paid for actual time spent providing services herein. No payment shall be made for travel time, equipment repairs or other incidental expenses. Contractor shall establish his/her hourly rate at a level sufficient to cover contingencies.
- 3.7 Contractor shall dispose of debris in a legal manner. If debris is transported to the Urban County Landfill, Contractor shall use a truck appropriate to load size to transport said debris. Payment will not be made for multiple disposal trips using a pick-up truck when use of a dump truck would be appropriate. A dump truck should be used if more than one (1) trip with a pick-up truck would be required.
- 3.8 Contractors will be required to take photos of the job site before and after the clean-up. Photos will be submitted for Code Enforcement with all other paperwork.
- 3.9 Contractors must respond within 24 hours to Code Enforcement with their bids.

4.0 DELIVERY

No requirements for delivery of services are established herein other than the response time specified in Section 3.1 above.

5.0 TESTING AND INSPECTION

No requirements for testing and inspection are established herein except that the Contractor shall correct work that does not meet the requirements of the Ordinances specified above.

6.0 NOTES

6.1 Contractor shall submit, with his/her bid, a listing of all equipment available for performance of this contract. The list shall specify the quantity and availability of each item listed below:

- 6.3 Upon completion of servicing a vacant lot, or other area, Contractor shall submit an invoice showing rates charged and total hours, date, and time of clean up.
- 6.4 Failure to respond to Code Enforcement's request for bids more than four (4) times in one (1) year will result in removal from the Contractor's list.
- 6.5 Contractors will normally be required to be in possession of all paperwork (copies or faxes permitted) at the job site when performing work.
