Rehab/Paving of the Town Brach WWTP Railroad Crossing

Request

The Division of Water Quality requests a resolution authorizing it to procure professional services from R.J. Corman Railroad Company, a sole source provider, for railroad crossing rehab services related to the existing grade crossing located at the Town Branch Wastewater Treatment Plant, at a cost not to exceed \$40,193.00, and authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to sign any necessary documents related to the procurement.

Purpose of Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request the sole source purchase of a Crossing Rehab (installation and asphalt for a 32' Rubber Rail Seal Crossing) at the Town Branch Waste Water Treatment Plant & Wet Weather Storage Tank facility railroad crossing for the total price of \$40,193.00 as quoted.

RJ Corman Railroad Company is the owner, operator, and the sole maintenance source of the railroad crossing. The maintenance services provided by RJ Corman Railroad Company parallel the uniqueness and exclusivity as utility providers such as Columbia Gas and Kentucky Utilities Company.

Project Cost in FY17 and in Future Budget Years

The project cost is \$40,193.00. There is no impact for future fiscal years.
