**SUBJECT: REQUEST COUNCIL AUTHORIZATION TO EXTEND PERIOD  
OF PERFORMANCE WITH URS CORPORATION, A NEVADA  
CORPORATION, FOR A TRAFFIC SIGNAL TIMING PROJECT  
UNDER THE ITS/CMS (INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION  
SYSTEM CONGESTION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM) TRAFFIC  
IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**


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On July 2, 2013 (Resolution No. 351-2013), Council approved the execution of an Engineering Services Agreement with URS Corporation, A Nevada Corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$349,599 for a Traffic Signal Timing Project, in response to RFP # 7-2013. The Traffic Signal Timing Project includes the development of twelve new timing plans for 35 intersections along specified corridors, including Georgetown Road, Versailles Road, Newtown Pike, and North Broadway. The purpose is to achieve optimized traffic flow, reduce emissions and enhance safety.

The completion date for this project was December 1, 2013. Due to difficulties in receiving quality traffic count data in a timely manner from its subcontractor, the contractor has requested additional time through April 18, 2014 to complete the project.

This project is supported with federal funds from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for the Intelligent Transportation System/Congestion Management System (ITS/CMS) Traffic Improvements Project., under the Surface Transportation Lexington (SLX) Program.

Council authorization to approve modification to Engineering Services Agreement with URS Corporation, A Nevada Corporation, providing for an extended performance period through April 18, 2014 is hereby requested.
