## Request

Request Council authorization to execute a Purchase of Service Agreement with the Kentucky Veterans Hall of Fame to hold their 2026 and 2027 Induction Ceremonies in Lexington. The term of this agreement starts on July 1, 2026 and lasts for a period of 24 months. LFUCG will provide a total of \$30,000 in funding for the two years of events. In the event of termination, a portion of compensation for services rendered is due to the Foundation. Events typically include an induction announcement and parachute drop, as well as induction dinner and induction ceremonies. LFUCG received sponsor recognition and a table at the dinner.

There have been 27 Fayette County residents inducted into the Kentucky Veterans Hall of Fame, and the organization has held their events in Lexington since 2018.

## **Reason for Request**

The Kentucky Veterans Hall of Fame celebrates and honors veterans who have continued to serve the public, once honorably leaving the military. It is important Lexington continues to improve and showcase support of veterans, and being the home of induction ceremonies helps in this endeavor.
