Request Council authorization to accept award of federal funds in the amount of \$43,000 from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for design of Town Branch Trail Crossing at Old Frankfort Pike and McConnell Springs Drive under the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program

On March 19, 2009 (Resolution 195-2009), Council approved submission of an application requesting funding under the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) program for design and construction of a crossing that provides a safe, at-grade crossing of Old Frankfort Pike at McConnell Springs Drive.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has offered the LFUCG design funds in the amount of \$43,000 for the design of this project. There is a required 20% local match for design which will be provided by the Municipal Aid program in the amount of \$10,750 for a total design cost of \$53,750.

Council authorization to accept the award is hereby requested.
